

Southern California Assisted Reproductive Biologists (SCARB)

Scholarship Application 2022

Two scholarship awards of up to \$2000 each, are available to current SCARB members in good standing. Applicant must be an active and practicing Embryologist or Andrologist, free-lance welcome. The awards may be applied towards expenses related to reproductive biology, including but not limited to conference registration/expenses, continuing educational and/or licensing expenses, or presentation/publication of research. Extra points will be awarded to individuals who have:

1. Intention to submit abstract/s to conference/s.
2. Previously accepted/published (last 12 months) original work to a journal/s.
3. Intention to sit an accredited exam or certification.

These awards cannot be used for accredited university programs.

Scholarships will be voted on and awarded by the elected SCARB Board Members and 2 appointed non-board members. Scholarship funds will be paid as a rebate of up to \$2000 to the awarded SCARB member and must be pre-approved by the board members prior to reimbursement.

To apply you must complete all pages of this application in full (type or print legibly). Any supplementary documents or additional facts that you wish the Scholarship Committee to consider in judging your eligibility may be added to your application.
